- b) 摘要提交截止日期为 2025 年 5 月 18 日。经审核后,主办单位将最迟于 2025 年 5 月 31 日发出正式的录取通知。逾期将不予考虑。
- c) 录取的发表者须在 2025 年 6 月 15 日前支付会议费用以利工作安排。未能完成付款者视同放弃发表。

10. Abstract Submission Guidelines

- i. Each participant must submit an abstract for evaluation before presenting their work at the conference. Abstracts must be submitted in English (300-500 words) or Chinese (500-800 words). Abstracts must be original and have not been presented or submitted to any other conferences.
- ii. All abstracts must be submitted by <u>18/5/2025</u>. Late submissions will NOT be considered. Please use the template provided to prepare your abstracts. Notification of acceptance or rejection will be sent to corresponding authors by <u>1/6/2025</u>. Once abstracts have been accepted and notified, participants must pay the fees for the conference by 15/6/2025.
- iii. Failing to complete the payment process would result in the participants refraining from proceeding to oral presentation sessions.
- iv. All submitted abstracts will undergo a peer review process. The program committee will select reviewers based on their expertise in the relevant field. Review criteria may include significance, originality, methodology, results, and references. Authors will receive feedback and review comments from the reviewers to help improve their abstracts.
- v. For ethical considerations, the conference committee reserves the right to address any ethical concerns during the review process. The circumstances include originality, plagiarism, copyright, and licensing. Authors are responsible for ensuring the originality of their work. Plagiarism, in any form, is strictly prohibited. Plagiarised papers will be subject to rejection, and authors may face further consequences as determined by the conference committee. Plagiarism detection tools may be used during the review process. Authors must agree to the conference's copyright and licensing policy terms.
- vi. All conference participants, including authors, are expected to adhere to a code of conduct that promotes respectful and professional behaviour. The organiser will detail inappropriate behaviours, consequences for violations, and reporting mechanisms in the code of conduct.

8. Oral Presentation

Participants can present their work at the conference in English or Chinese language. The recommended presentation time is between 10 and 15 minutes, maximum NOT more than 15 minutes. Participants can choose their presentation mode through virtual or physical sessions and prepare their presentation slides during the oral presentation session. Exceeding the maximum presentation time may result in the program committee interrupting the presentation. Panels will provide comments to participants after their presentation to improve their work. The rules and regulations of the conference are subject to change. Hence, participants are advised to regularly check the conference "RULES AND REGULATIONS" and additional information regarding the abstract submission process and other related matters.
